Two dog bins were purchased, which are well used and a waste bin at The Pond. This had also been dredged The second instalment of the speed sign had been paid. Therefore, the balance at the end of March 2017 was £6183.23

5.District Councillor Report: District Councillor Kate Cook gave a brief overview of the digital hub at Osbournby, the success of the cluster meetings thanks to the attendance of parish councillors. An update on matters NKDC is attached to these minutes.

6.Presentation of Emergency Plan: The Chairman explained that under Lincolnshire County Council regulations Silk Willoughby Parish Council have to have in place a community emergency plan for any major incident that occurs within the parish boundaries. He said that as you are well aware we can't plan for the incident, all we can do is plan and manage the aftermath, hoping it will work on the day. Broadband – An ongoing issue as to when Silk Willoughby will receive Superfast Broadband. The dates keep changing. The last report the Clerk had was Phase 3 01 January to 31 September 2018. Now it appears it could even be 2020. County Councillor Hagues and District Councillor Cook agreed to push BT for a better timescale
